The Following documents are required for the application process:

- ◆ Certified Birth Certificate
- ◆ Income Verification such as W-2 Check Stub, Tax Form 1040, Public Assistance Status
- ◆ Social Security Number
- ◆ Medicaid/Insurance Number
- ◆ Immunization Certificate
- ◆ Medical Examination or Well Child Check
- ◆ Dental Examination
- ◆ Referral documents
(only if child receives services from other agencies)

Early Head Start offers Services to children 6 Wks. - 35 months as well as expectant mothers, children with Disabilities and the Homeless.

To be categorically eligible for Head Start/Early Head Start Services:

- ◆ A family that receives public assistance, TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) or SSI (Supplemental Security Income) programs
- ◆ Children in foster care, regardless of family income
- ◆ Homeless children as the meaning given the term "homeless children and youths" in section 725(2) of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act
