# **Poetry Slam Registration and Rules**

### **Poetry Slam Registration-Ages 12-20**

#### How does the Poetry Slam work?

First, one individual from each organization receives a chance to perform an original poem. Next, individual poets can perform their original poem. The highest scoring individual from each organization will win a cash prize. All participants receive recognition. All original teens' poems will be **written about "Prescription Drug Misuse" (consumption, consequences, etc.).** 

#### **Poetry Slam Scoring**

There will be five qualified judges. Each judge will receive a set of scoring cards, with whole numbers (1-10).

Categories & Prizes –  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$ ,  $3^{rd}$  place and Honorable Mentioned winners will receive cash prize. All participants will receive recognition.

1 <sup>st</sup> Place Prize	\$50.00
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place Prize	\$25.00
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place Prize	\$15.00
Honorable Mentioned	\$10.00

**Bouts:** Only in the event of a tie there will be a second bout.

- First bout: All contestants will receive an opportunity to perform.
- **Second bout:** Only contestants whose score ties with someone.

#### **Poetry Slam Rules**

#### Rules

- Ages 12-20
- Poems must be original.
- 12-point Font in Times New Roman
- Double-spaced
- Include Name, Grade and Age, Title of Poem, and Name of Organization.
- · Absolutely no profanity is allowed.
- No props!
- This is a performance, not a reading. Choreographed movements and other unique expressions are encouraged.
- Each contestant must submit a **Parent Consent & Release form signed by a** parent/guardian to participate. Parent Consent & Release-Poetry Slam
- Performances are timed. Each poet gets three minutes (plus a ten-second grace period). If the poet goes over time, points will be deducted from the total score.
- Participants must submit a written copy of the poem they plan to perform at least 3
  days in advance via email to bautry@altalpointe.org
- Students who attend the slam must be accompanied by a teacher, parent, director, or a coach. If you need more information, contact me via email to bautry@altapointe.org.
