Demopolis is the largest city in marengo County, in west central Alabama. The population was 7,162 at the time of the 2020 United States census. The city lies at the confluence of the Black Warrior River and Tombigbee River.

This city is one of the four cities accepted for the Main Street Alabama Project which will kick off on June 28, 2022.

Demopolis was chosen by MSA after a long process of applications and presentations presented to the MSA board which was looking for towns with a rich history and historic buildings that needed to be preserved.

One of the very events to be hosted is the farmer's market in the beautiful downtown square.
