



# Balloon Release Memorial Held for Madison "Skip" Nicholson

Camden, AL (27 June 2022) — Family, friends, co-workers, political officials, non-profit agencies, and organizations gathered today in front of the Wilcox County Courthouse to release balloons in memory of Madison "Skip" Nicholson, a retired Sheriff Deputy, who was killed while responding to a domestic violence call on December 1, 2021.
