COST?

The program costs \$850. Full or partial scholarships will be available on a limited basis thanks to the Women in Business Conference and Minerva sponsors.

The program fee includes UA residential hall accommodations, all meals, classroom sessions with UA Culverhouse faculty, expert advice on applying to college (including seminars on admissions requirements, financial aid, and housing), field trips, service project, supplies, Minerva t-shirt, a closing banquet for students and parents, group photo, and certificate of completion.
